CALL FOR PAPERS

The Anti-Counterfeit Authority is planning to host the 2nd International Symposium on Intellectual Property Protection and Enforcement (ISIPPE2) on the 5th-6th June 2024 at the Kenyatta International Convention Centre (KICC) as part of the global events observing the World Anti-Counterfeiting Day.

This is a call for papers to be presented during the symposium. Authors are expected to submit abstracts first for review and once accepted the full papers for subsequent publication in a Discussion Paper Series published by the Authority. The overall theme of the symposium is "Uniting against counterfeits for a healthy and safe future."

- Abstracts should be written in clear and concise English language;
- Abstracts should have a maximum of 300 words; must have a clear and concise title, a brief introduction (purpose), methodology, results and conclusion;
- Authors can submit case reviews, cases studies, emerging best practices, innovations and new knowledge;
- Abstracts should be aligned with the symposium theme and sub-themes:
- Authors must indicate the respective sub-theme or sub-themes:
- Abstracts should include the name(s) of the author(s), affiliations, and contact address;
